2 mile marker

- Runners will begin on the football field goal line and run out the back parking lot gate onto the dirt road.  
- Dirt road will lead runners onto the ditch which will take them to Burgundy St. Once runners reach Burgundy they are 1 mile into their race.  
- Runners will remain on the outer portion of the ditch (the 2 mile point will be marked) and turn around once they reach Northloop.  
- Once runners reach the Northloop turnaround, they will follow the dirt path to a small ditch and loop that before heading back into the stadium for the finish.  
Course is 3.1 miles.

BURGENDY ST.  
1 MILE MARKER



- Runners will begin on the football field goal line and head out the back gate onto the gravel road.

- Gravel road will lead runners to the ditch, which will take them out to Burgundy St. The turn-around at this point is the 1 mile mark.

- Runners will return on the opposite side of the ditch and return to the stadium the same way they headed out.

- **THIS COURSE IS 2 MILES LONG**
