<u>Field Events</u>: - Begin at 3:00 p.m. with the <u>best flight first</u> in all events in the following order:

Girls Long Jump followed by Boys Long Jump

Boys Shot Put followed by Girls Shot Put

Boys High Jump followed by Girls High Jump

Girls Discus followed by Boys Discus

The announcer will make 3 calls for each event. 1<sup>st</sup> call approximately 15 minutes before the event; 2<sup>nd</sup> call approximately 10 minutes before the event; 3<sup>rd</sup> call approximately 5 minutes before the event. All athletes must report to their event on the 3<sup>rd</sup> call – for running events, athletes report to the starting line or an area near the starting line for that event (all members of relay teams must report); for field events, athletes report to the field event judge in the event area. Failing to report on the 3<sup>rd</sup> call may result in being scratched from the event.

Medley: North Ogden, Sand Ridge, Wahlquist 2 teams, TH Bell 1 team

4 X 200: Sand Ridge, Wahlquist, TH Bell 2 teams, North Ogden 1 team

School assignments are rotated alphabetically for all the above entries. Assignments will be rotated each year.

## Distance:

800 – 2 heats: Heat 1 – 5 entrants per school; Heat 2 – unlimited entries

Long Jump, Discus, Shot: each school gets 5 entrants, 3 jumps or throws only

High Jump: each school gets 5 entrants, 2 attempts only at first 2 heights

The Host Jr. High School is responsible for sending five (5) faculty members to help at the meet. Four will supervise a field event (one each at the Long Jump, High Jump, Shot Put, Discus). High school athletes will run those events, the faculty member is there to supervise and assist with any problems or questions that may arise. The fifth faculty member will be assigned to help with crowd control (Keeping spectators off the football field, the track, or other areas of the stadium that are not for spectators).
