MEET INFORMATION AND ENTRY INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. The meet has been sanctioned and will be used for state qualifying purposes.
- 2. Meet entry will be on runnercard.com. The access code is: titans
- 3. Entry deadline is Tuesday, March 22 at 9:00 am. The meet will be closed at that date/time.
- 4. Cost for the meet is \$250 per school (\$125 boys/\$125 girls)
- 5. No additions will be allowed after registration is complete.
- 6. The charge for spectators will be \$3.00 for adults and students older than 6. Children 5 and under are free. **Please let your athlete's parents know**.
- 7. All entry will be through the South gates of the stadium. There is an exit/entrance in the Northeast corner for the discus and javelin events, but only coaches, athletes and spectators with a stamp will be allowed in.
- 8. Canopies are NOT allowed in the west bleachers. Canopies in the east bleachers are fine.
- 9. **Teams are allowed 4 entries per event.** We will get marks for all athletes in running events and field events.
- 10. Jumping heights:
 - High Jump Boys 5'6", 5'8", 5'10", 6'0"(5A), 6'2"(6A) (+2 inches thereafter)

Girls 4'5", 4'7", 4'09", 4'11"(5A), 5'1" (6A) (+2 inches thereafter)

- Pole Vault Boys 9'0", 9'06", 10'00"(5A), 10'6", 11'00", 11'6", 12'0", 12'6", 12'10"(6A) (+4 ...) Girls 6'06", 7'00", 7'6"(5A), 8'0", 8'6", 9'0", 9'4", 9'8"(6A) (+4 ...)
- 11. Athletes should report to the starting line or field event area at first call.
- 12. We will score eight (8) places, and will include marks from all heats and flights. The Finish Lynx timing system will be used. Individual events and relays will be scored: 10 8 6 5 4 3 2 1
- 13. Shot Put, Discus, Javelin and Long Jump contestants will have three (3) attempts in the trials. The top nine (9) will advance into the finals for an additional three attempts.
- 14. Multiple heats will be contested in the 800, 1600, and 3200 runs. Heats will be arranged with the top 16 runners placed in the fast (final) heat, and the remainder in the slower (unseeded) heat(s).
- 15. Uniform rules will be in effect. Be sure your athletes are in legal school issued uniforms.
- 16. Medals will be awarded the top six in individual events as well as to the members of the top three winning relay teams. An Outstanding Athlete and Outstanding Performance for male and female athletes will be awarded as well as team awards. The Outstanding Athlete will be voted upon by coaches. The Outstanding Performance will be based upon the performance points chart.
- 17. All awards will be presented on Thursday. <u>Awards earned Wednesday will be presented beginning at 2:30</u> on Thursday. Let your winning athletes know to be there! We want to recognize all winning athletes!
- 18. **Event Assignments- each school will be asked to staff the following events:** We will provide tape measures, clipboards, and flight sheets. You will need an event manager and all necessary helpers.
