Admission & Entrances

- Athletes & Coaches Dropped off and enter through the South Gates (not the tunnel).
- Fans Parents / Family members of athletes participating will check in at the flagpole entrances.
- Pass list Only fans that are on the pass list submitted by the head track coach will be allowed in.

Bus Parking

• All school team buses/school vans will park on the south side of the stadium between the Aquatics Center and the South Gate entrance to the SAC.

Uniforms

- UIL uniform rules will apply amended from the NFHS rules of the current year. Boys must wear shorts. All relay members must be in compliance with UIL rules.
- An athlete checked into a competition must be in full uniform. The uniform must be worn during check in and at the competition site.
- Only rubber bands, string, ribbon, beads woven into hair or soft bands without metal may be worn in the hair. Metal clips, bobby pins, or barrettes no longer than 2" may be worn during competition. No hard plastic or metal bands.

All School Assignments:

Each school will be responsible for providing 3 workers for field events or running events.

Packet Pickup:

• All packets may be picked up in the home locker room at the SAC beginning at 7:30 a.m. on Wednesday, March 31st.

Para Events:

• Wheel-chair athletes will compete at the designated time according to the meet schedule. Schools may contact the meet director to accommodate specific circumstances for para events.

Field Events:

- The horizontal jumps and throws events will have 3 preliminary trials. The (8) best efforts will be given (3) final attempts. Athletes will compete in reverse order for final attempts. 3 preliminary FOULS will result in forfeiture of any final attempts.
- Shot & Disc Weigh In: All Shot puts will be weighed in from 8:00-8:15 am. Discus will be weighed in from 8:15-8:30 a.m. Implements will be weighed in the Storage Room next to the visitor locker room under the scoreboard. Implements not approved will be impounded until the meet is over.
- Athletes are responsible for checking out their implement when competition is over.



Electronic Devices

- Noise related electronic devices are not allowed on the infield.
- Radios, speakers, walkie talkies or other sound devices are not allowed in the stands or areas of competition.

Spikes: Only ¼ inch pyramid spikes are allowed.



Team Camps

- All team camps must be placed on the west side of the stadium (press box side).
- Teams will be assigned a section in the stadium. Section 1-8 (See pg. 2 for team #).
- Trash containers will be provided throughout the stadium.
- No team camps allowed on the infield at any time.

Field Access

- Only competitors warming up, and officials are allowed on the infield.
- Coaches must remain in the stands for running event segments.
- Coach must remain in coaching boxes for field events.
- Please keep bags off the infield.
- Field judges will instruct coaches at the site of the designated areas.

Check-in, Warm-up, & Competition

- Athletes competing should enter through the tunnel and report to receive hip numbers.
- Athletes may use the infield turf for warm-ups.
- Athletes should not carry bags into the warm-up area.
- All athletes/relay (all 4 members) must check-in to the staging area prior to competition.
- Lane assignments will be verified at the staging area.
- All athletes must check in prior to all field events with the lead event official.
- Blocks will be provided at the starting line.

Athletic Trainers:

- Socorro ISD will provide training services for athletes in front of the visitor locker room.
- Athletes will be asked to bring their own water.
- Refill stations are located at the Athletic Trainer station.

Awards:

Medals and Trophies will be delivered to participating schools the week after the district meet.

Stadium Regulations:

The following items are not allowed on the field or track:

- Tobacco or tobacco products
- Gum
- Shelled nuts / Seeds
- Sandbags
- Food or Drinks

Umbrellas may be used in the stadium provided they do not obstruct the view of others. Patrons using umbrellas will be asked to sit in the upper levels of the stadium. Alcohol, tobacco, and tobacco products are not allowed on school district property, to include the SAC. Animals, with the exception of guide dogs or canine officers, are not allowed in the stadium.

Vehicles/Emergency Access: Vehicular access to the track and field is prohibited to all vehicles, except SISD gators or golf carts. Exceptions may be made and approved by the Department of Athletics. In case of a medical emergency, an EMS vehicle may be directed onto the track or field.

Equipment: All equipment brought into the SAC must be rubber-based or rubber-tipped. Sharp edges can damage the track and artificial grass field and are not allowed. Solid weights (not sandbags) must be used to secure air-inflated school mascot run-throughs, and other similar items. Items in question must be approved by the Department of Athletics prior to use at games or during the pre-game, halftime, or postgame performances or activities.

Weather: Lightening in the area will result in a 30-minute weather delay. Patrons may be asked to exit the stadium in an orderly fashion; they may remain on the premises in their vehicle until it is safe to return. Events postponed or cancelled will be completed at the next available date, time, and location as agreed upon by athletic directors of the participating schools and pending official availability.
